

# MASS RIDE 2

**INTO WINCHESTER @10.00**

## ROUTE A) KINGSWORTHY → KING ALFRED'S STATUE

Meet	Details	Pause & easy joining point @ 10.15
Outside Tesco Express on Springvale Road	3½ miles 30-35 mins	Grass area at top of Bedfield Lane

## ROUTE B) HARESTOCK & WEEKE → KING ALFRED'S STATUE

Meet	Details	Pause & easy joining point @ 10.15
Outside Tesco Express on Prior's Dean Road	2¾ miles 25-30 mins	Grass area at corner of Stoney Lane and Stockbridge Road

## ROUTE C) BADGER FARM & STANMORE → KING ALFRED'S STATUE

Meet	Details	Pause & easy joining point @ 10.15
On the grass opposite Sainsbury's emergency exit on Meadow Way	3 miles 25-30 mins	In front of the shops on Cromwell Road

**AROUND WINCHESTER (optional) @10.40**

Important: the rides from out of town will aim to merge on North Walls and then continue on to circle the roundabout at King Alfred's Statue *but without pausing*.

Cyclists wanting to participate only in the ride around town should *be ready to join the mass ride as it passes by King Alfred's Statue* but please *take particular care about buses and coaches in that area*.

Cyclists coming in from out of town who don't have the stamina for the full inner city route can either choose to leave the ride at this point and be first in the queue for a drink and mince pie in Abbey Gardens or they can take the Parchment Street short-cut whilst on the loops.

## TWO LAPS of the INNER CITY LOOP

**KING ALFRED'S STATUE – ST GEORGE'S STREET – JEWRY STREET – NORTH WALLS – EASTGATE STREET – ST GEORGE'S STREET – JEWRY STREET – NORTH WALLS – EASTGATE STREET – KING ALFRED'S STATUE**

2 ½ miles, 20 mins

**RIDE ENDS IN WINCHESTER @11.00**
