## INTO WINCHESTER @10.00

### ROUTE A) KINGSWORTHY → KING ALFRED'S STATUE

### ROUTE B) HARESTOCK & WEEKE → KING ALFRED'S STATUE

## AROUND WINCHESTER @10.40

The rides from out of town *will merge on North Walls* and then continue on to circle the roundabout at King Alfred's Statue *but without pausing*. Cyclists wanting to participate only in the ride around town should *be ready to join the mass ride as it passes by King Alfred's Statue* but please *take particular care about buses and coaches in that area*.

Cyclists coming in from out of town who don't have the stamina for the full inner city route can either leave the ride the first time of reaching King Alfred's Statue and be first in the queue for a drink and snack in Abbey Gardens or use the Parchment Street short-cut whilst on the loops (see route maps).

**KING ALFRED'S STATUE - ST GEORGE'S STREET - JEWRY STREET - NORTH WALLS - EASTGATE STREET - ST GEORGE'S STREET - JEWRY STREET - NORTH WALLS - EASTGATE STREET - KING ALFRED'S STATUE**  
2 ½ miles, 20 mins
